The Nexus Family Violence Therapeutic Interventions Project (FV-TIP) will provide new ways of intensive therapeutic support to women, children and their families who have experienced family violence within the Mitchell & Murrindindi Shires.

Our service is confidential and respectful of your needs, circumstances and culture.

Nexus FV-TIP can provide the following therapeutic interventions:

- **Allied Health:** (Speech Pathology and Occupational Therapy) for children with developmental delays,
- **Theraplay®:** a trauma-informed attachment-based therapy for children and women,
- **Nexus Horses Assisting You (HAY):** Equine Therapy Program for children and women.

This project seamlessly connects participants with all services offered by Nexus services including specialist Family Violence Support Services such as Children's Counselling and Men's Behaviour Change.

The Victorian Government is trialling new ways to provide intensive therapeutic support to women, children and their families experiencing family violence.

The new pilot projects support recommendations from the Royal Commission into Family Violence to improve accessibility, transform the way the system responds to family violence, and support family violence services to strengthen and enhance its therapeutic response to adults and children impacted by family violence.

A total of 26 projects across Victoria – including four that specifically target Aboriginal families – will be funded until June 2018.
