Podiatry provides advice, treatment and prevention for feet and lower limb conditions which may affect your movement, comfort and quality of life.

Our service is confidential and respectful of your needs, circumstances and culture.

A Nexus Podiatrist can assist people of all ages and abilities with:

- N Routine foot and nail care,
- Problematic foot issues in children.
- Warts, corns and calluses,
- Diabetes foot assessments and care,
- Nound and ulcer management,
- N Foot or ankle pain,
- Ingrown toenails including minor surgical procedures (at extra cost),
- Sports injuries,
- N Taping and supports,
- Orthotics (at extra cost),
- Footwear assessments and advice.

What to expect at your appointment:

<u>Initial consultations</u> may take up to 60 mins and will include a detailed assessment of your current situation to tailor your treatment plan to your needs.

<u>Standard consultations</u> may take up to 30 minutes and will include treatment as per your initial plan.
