Are you Under 65 and have a disability or complex health issue?

Are you NOT eligible for NDIS funding?

Do you need in-home care or assistance?

Then you are looking for Home and Community Care for younger people.

Nexus Primary Health provides these services in City of Greater Shepparton, Strathbogie Shire. Mitchell Shire and Murrindindi Shire.

An assessor from Nexus can meet with you at home to discuss your eligibility for this service.

The assessor can also make referrals to any relevant services that you agree to, to provide support for you to live independently at home.

What do we offer?

- Shopping and meal preparation assistance
- Domestic assistance
- Hygiene assistance
- Respite care
- Property maintenance (if unsafe for you or your family to do)

What to expect?

Our assessors will come to your home to discuss what your support needs are and your eligibility. You may choose to have a family member or close friend present during this assessment.

Our team

Our assessors have a broad range of skills and backgrounds to get an understanding of your needs. Our team of Community Support Workers are also well trained and skilled to be able to provide your services with you.

What do these services cost?

You will be charged fees for your services that will be affordable to you based on your income. These will be discussed with you. There is no cost for the assessment.
